Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct defines what is expected from CRPA members to ensure a safe and positive playing experience and appropriate behaviors at all times. These behaviors are consistent with the essential values of safety, respect, fairness, honesty, and integrity. Every CRPA member is obliged to:

- treat others with respect
- exhibit fairness and honesty in dealings with others
- not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct, and to encourage others in the same behaviour
- not engage in any behavior that would endanger the health, safety or wellbeing of others
- not engage in the use of profanity, harassment or bullying
- not engage in public criticism of other players or officials
- not use or exploit CRPA members for business purposes or financial gain
- be welcoming to visiting players
- create a positive pickleball experience for all.
